Bobby Jones said, “There are any number of people who have devoted enough thought, time and effort to the game to become reasonably good, if they had only started out with an accurate conception of what to do.” How many times have you stood on the practice range with no clue how to fix your swing? If you’re like me, it’s often. Michael Breed, 2012 PGA Teacher of the Year and host of Golf Channel’s *The Golf Fix* says, “It’s hard to fix a golfer’s swing if they can’t see their faults.” SkyPro, the “hot” new swing analyzer from SkyGolf, helps you see your swing faults in order to give you, as Jones described, an “accurate conception” of how to improve.

The innovative SkyPro weighs less than an ounce (23.5g), attaches easily to any club shaft and is virtually undetectable when swinging. With no on/off switch necessary, hundreds of critical data points including swing path, clubhead speed, swing plane and much more, are sent instantly via Bluetooth to a free iOS app (for Apple iPhone 4/4s/5, iPod Touch 5th gen. and iPad 2/3) to view. Impressive 3D playbacks of swings captured at ultra-high speeds (3,200 samples per second) are displayed in vivid high definition providing much more accurate swing data than typical video (30 to 60 frames per second) or motion capture (120 frames per second) technology used for swing analysis.

Golf’s most powerful swing analyzer and training tool, SkyPro is a reference point for success and a vital, instant indicator of where and when your swing is off. Checkpoint alerts provide immediate feedback of each swing and deliver information you’ll need to improve. You can actually look at your swing while you’re practicing, and thousands of swings can be stored in an online account for more detailed analysis.

Herb Meistrich, President of TaylorMade Performance Labs, marveled, “At the TaylorMade Performance Labs we measure a golfer’s detailed swing characteristics using motion capture technology to design clubs that fit that particular swing. In addition to the fitting, we show customers in 3D exactly what they are doing and what to work on to improve their game. With SkyPro, golfers can confirm on the practice range whether changes they are trying to apply are actually effective. The ability to deduce this during practice is invaluable.
