you're a golf geek like me, you just want to get in there. They have everything. They order your equipment, build it for you, and ensure what you're using is helping your golf game. If they don't find anything clearly better, they simply tell you."

Frank D'Angelo (6-handicap, Malvern, PA) has been going to Club Champion for four years and among other clubs, was fitted for Mizuno MP 25 irons. While anyone can benefit from premium club fitting, it is meant for golfers who want optimized performance. Terry tracks his statistics and averaged 235 yards with his old driver. He purchased a Callaway Great Big Bertha driver with a Fujikura Pro shaft and has not hit a drive less than 250 yards since. "I went all last year without a driver in my bag because my misses were not acceptable. What's changed? The first par-5 I played this year, I got there in two! Last time out, I hit 13 out of 14 fairways, and about 70% were driver."
